



Entries Policy 2023

BEDE Events will operate a new entry system at our events in 2023. We will accept class entries in the order in which they are received. By operating this system, we hope that everybody will have an equal chance of competing at our events. As with any new system there will be some lessons to learn, however we hope that this will enable riders to confidently enter early to ensure they get a run. We aim to be as flexible as possible, and will endeavour to work with you to ensure we develop a fair and easy system.

All entries will be hidden until sectioning takes place.

Entries from full members (Premier, Standard & Introductory) will take priority. Horses must have a season ticket (not PAYG) and owners must be full members (not PAYG) for priority entry. If after seven days of entries being opened, further entries can be accommodated, then entries that have one or more PAYG membership type (i.e. Rider, Owner or Horse) will be accepted. All BE members will be offered a full refund if they withdraw within seven days of the entries opening.

Please do not use ballot/priority stickers as they will not be applicable.

As per BE rules, we will accept a maximum of five entries per rider, per day. This may have to be reduced to three per level to accommodate timetable irregularities.

Classes will close when a capacity of 90% has been reached and entries after that will be put onto a waitlist. The waitlist will be created in time and date order. This will enable the Organisers to create a working timetable. The additional 10% will be taken from the waitlist.
